お茶の水女子大学 グローバルリーダーシップ研究所海外特別招聘教授、ドイツ デュースブルク・エッセン大学教授、デュースブルク・エッセン大学東アジア研究所教授。2016年10月1日、特別招聘教授として本学に着任し、リーダーシップ研究・教育を担当。 Wisconsin 大学マディソン校で博士号(社会学)を取得後、国際基督教大学(ICU)准教授(1990-99年)。専門は比較社会学、日本学。雇用におけるジェンダー不平等についての日独の国際比較や東アジアとヨーロッパの地域比較を行うなど、国際的な研究・教育活動を行っている。

Professor at the Institute of East Asian Studies, University of Duisburg-Essen and currently Distinguished Visiting Professor at the Institute for Global Leadership, Ochanomizu University. In 1990s, she served as Associate Professor at International Christian University for 8 years. She is actively doing a worldwide research and educational activities on gender inequalities in employment through international comparison between Japan and Germany, and area comparison between East Asia and Europe.

Her main research interests include family, population ageing and health service utilization. Her major publications include books entitled Age-Boom Generation: Preparing for the Ageing Society (2004). Koreans in the US, Abortions in Korea, and Qualitative Methodology.

From 2001 to 2009, Dr. Anzai was President of Keio University. He is Executive Adviser for Academic Affairs of Keio University since 2009. From Feb. 2014 to Feb. 2015, he was Chair of the 7th Central Council for Education University Subcommittee.

His recent publications include Mind and Brain: Introduction to Cognitive Science (2011) and Education Gives Future to Japan (2008).
